48%
of Americans

said credit card theft has made them **more reluctant to make an online purchase**. But Google is making money by sharing what appears to be access to stolen credit cards.

When searching terms like “CC number with CVV” and “CC with CVV and SSN” on the Google-owned property, YouTube, **Digital Citizens found over 38,000 listings**. (Many promising to sell stolen credit information.)



37%
of Americans

report that they have had their credit card **stolen** or compromised — including 45% of those respondents 65-years-old and over.

84%
of Americans

said that it's a “**serious**” issue having thieves hacking into retailers to steal card numbers. 58% call it “very serious.”



88% of Americans said Google had a responsibility to make the Internet safer.
